

2024 MVHS TX-20009th AFJROTC BOOSTER CLUB ACADEMIC AND MILITARY ENLISTMENT SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

1. Any graduating cadet from Medina Valley High School & those enrolled in the AFJROTC program meet the basic requirement to apply.
2. Must have been accepted to a 2 or 4-year college/University/Vocational program with an academic start date after graduation or enlisting in the military.
3. High School GPA of 3.0 or higher (for college/university) and meet minimum entry for military if entering a military branch.
4. Community service requirement for the cadet is ten (10) hours per year in program and for parents/family/cadet each year is ten (10) hours with the booster club.
5. The recipient(s) awarded the scholarship(s) will be notified at the JROTC Award Night with a courtesy notice to the Medina Valley High School Counselor.
6. Only completed scholarship applications will be considered. A complete and neat packet includes:
 - a. Scholarship Application (with all required fields complete)
 - b. 2 Letters of Recommendation
 - c. One essay between 400 to 800 words (double space, Times New Roman, size 12 font). Topic: What did JROTC teach you that will help you prepare for college, university, vocational, school life, or the military?
7. Hand deliver application and all forms to:
The instructor on the scholarship committee by **Wednesday, March 1, 2024 by 4:30 pm**.
This deadline is firm and will not be extended. No late applications will be accepted.
8. If you feel there should be an exception to policy on any criteria, then it must be submitted in writing and included with the scholarship package.
9. The Scholarship Committee will contact final candidates to schedule interviews.

***Scholarships will only be awarded for any educational expense or in the case of enlistment any expense getting prepared for basic training. ***

****The Scholarship Committee in conjunction with the Executive Board members can reevaluate the process and criteria in awarding the scholarships to benefit the cadet with the board being the final approval authority.****
